



CAR ACCIDENT CHECKLIST

IMMEDIATELY AFTER CAR ACCIDENT:

- CHECK YOURSELF/PASSENGERS FOR INJURIES**
 - Does anyone have noticeable injuries?
 - Does anyone have major injuries?
- CALL POLICE**
 - Let them know the location of the accident- look for mile markers, landmarks, street signs, or anything else that could be useful.
 - Ask if it is ok to move vehicles, if no injuries or if it's advisable.
- TAKE PICTURES OF THE ACCIDENT**
 - Make sure it is safe to do so!
 - Try to take pictures before you move the vehicles, **ONLY IF SAFE.**
 - If vehicles have been moved, then take pictures of the damage.
- MOVE VEHICLE TO SIDE OF ROAD**
 - If it is safe and/or police have advised you to do so, then move vehicles to side of road.
- GO TO ER**
 - Are children present? Children may not be able to express what is wrong, they may need to be taken to ER.
 - Did police advise you to go, if so, then don't delay.
- FIND WHERE CAR IS TOWED**
 - Once immediate danger is over, ask where car is towed. The Police officer on scene may know or you may see the tow vehicle:
